- Develop training programs both long and short term
- At the completion of each National event, shall ensure report is prepared on each player's performance/participation/image portrayed.

# **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The successful applicant will be expected to demonstrate the following essential requirements and in the case of equal qualifications between two or more applicants, most if not all of the desirable requirements.

# **ESSENTIAL:**

- 1. High level interpersonal skills, willingness to listen, an ability to recognize anxious behaviour and to appropriate action.
- 2. High level oral and written communication skills.
- 3. High level organization and management skills
- 4. Understanding and acceptance of the responsibilities of the State Coach
- 5. Have proven experience in this or similar roles previously, and have coached at a high level of competition.
- 6. Must be a current accredited BA coach
- 7. Have a working with children clearance
- 8. Must be able to maintain player/coach confidentiality at all times
- 9. Be willing to undertake a criminal history check if required
- 10. Provide two references.
